

PRACTICE NOTE 8 of 2018 – Caveats

This Practice Note is issued on 16 November 2018 under Rules 4A, 5(8), 5(11) and 5(12) and takes effect on 26 November 2018

Unless otherwise ordered or directed:

1. Compliance with Rule 52(2) is dispensed with.
2. A caveat may be entered in the appropriate online form in CourtSA.
3. Compliance with Rule 52(6) is dispensed with.
4. A caveat may be warned by completion of the online form in CourtSA in the case in CourtSA in which the caveat was entered.
5. Compliance with Rule 52(7) is dispensed with.
6. A caveat may be withdrawn at any time before the entry of any appearances to a warning and the caveat thereupon ceases to take effect. The withdrawal may be made in the online form in CourtSA in the case in CourtSA in which the caveat was entered.
7. Compliance with Rule 52(8) is dispensed with.
8. A caveator having an interest contrary to that of the person warning may enter an appearance at any time before an affidavit has been filed under subrule (10). The appearance is to be entered in the online form in CourtSA in the case in CourtSA in which the caveat was entered.
